

Protection of Visitors in EEA Countries

In its capacity of UK guarantee fund, MIB asked the guarantee funds of EEA states to sign bilateral Protection of Visitors agreements covering victims of uninsured or untraced (i.e. hit-and-run) drivers. The agreements include a reciprocal clause committing both sides to compensate visitors who are resident in the other country. In some cases, both sides were able to give an assurance that compensation would continue to be available without a formal agreement. The agreements signed/assurances received are listed below:
