






vehicles identified as uninsured via MID/ANPR systems

ANPR cameras

13,600 fixed 1,800 mobile 78 million numberplate captures a day



Letters sent to registered keepers, branded from local police force

Additional versions for Welsh language and Scottish legislation

Tutelage Plus

Any vehicles identified as also having no MOT and tax are automatically placed on the **VOI** (no letter sent)



57% take positive action to get insurance




43% don't respond, added to Vehicle of Interest list (VOI) issued to police forces

Predicted Movements: Case Study

Prior to roll-out, one roads policing unit ran a seven-day pilot to test the predictive analytics.

Four vehicles were identified in the area that offered a predicted location within a 15minute timeframe

Summary

- All four vehicles seen and stopped on the road within the 15-minute timeframes identified
- All four vehicles confirmed to have no valid insurance, no current MOT, no tax
- All four vehicles seized, and drivers reported for offences including driving and other criminal maters

The success of Op Tutelage means the insurance industry can support the police in getting the most dangerous drivers off our roads as soon as possible.

Impact of Operation Tutelage



Operation Tutelage continues to drive behaviour change, as well as identifying secondary offences.



Registered keepers who were sent an Op Tutelage letter were **4.4 times more likely to get insurance** for their vehicle than those who were not sent a letter



A new insurance policy was taken out **every 3 minutes** in 2023 due to Op Tutelage



62.7% of vehicles stopped and seized due to a Tutelage marker were identified to have secondary offences
